- 270 000 donor samples / year
- 4000 antibody identifications for patient samples / year
- 81 000 antibody screenings for antenatal samples / year

Number of Donors in Database:

- All together 790 000 donors
- 169 rare donors

 - Pk donors
- family studies after finding a propositus
 - □ Jk:-3, Pk, LWa-, Vel neg, Rh:-51
- in near future with molecular screening and ethnic donor screening Number of Rare Donor units used per year:
- 30-40 fresh units and 20 frozen units are send to the customers
